## **GLEP Endorses 20 Additional Candidates in Legislative Races** *Bi-partisan education advocacy group has made 53 campaign endorsements*

**Lansing, MI** – The Great Lakes Education Project (GLEP) today announced additional endorsements in a number of campaigns for the State Senate and State House of Representatives.

“We’re very proud to endorse these 53 outstanding individuals in these 50 races,” said Gary Naeyaert, GLEP Executive Director. “Political elections are hard fought contests. We urge every voter to take a good look at their past records and positions on key issues and make the important decisions about which candidates to support,” Naeyaert continued.

GLEP’s endorsement process includes an examination of past voting records, personal interviews and results from the organization’s extensive candidate questionnaire. It should be noted that priority issues for GLEP include school choice and early literacy, while there are a number of education policy issues for which endorsed candidates may hold a variety of positions, including K-12 funding, Common Core State Standards, student assessments, etc. Additional endorsements may still be made in the 2014 Primary Election.
